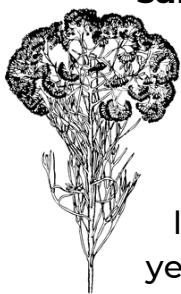
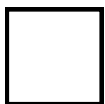
How many of these plants can you find in the garden?

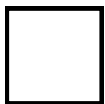
Athanasia crithmifolia
samphire-leaf athanasia (E)
klaaslouwbossie (A)



A rounded, compact bush with with small, silvery-green, needle-like leaves. With bright yellow flower heads in spring, at attracts small insects.



Ehrharta calycina
Common veld grass (E)
Rooigras (A)



A tufted, medium-sized, quick-growing grass with soft, blue-green foliage. It looks slightly wispy and feathery when flowering



Leucadendron salignum
Common sunshine conebush (E)
Geelbos (A)



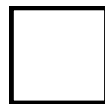
The brightly coloured leaves surround the cone-like flowers, advertising their pollen to insects.

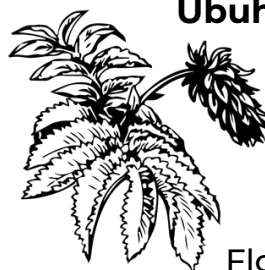
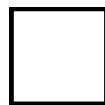
Zantedeschia aethiopica
Common arum lily (E)
Wit varkoor (A)
Intebe (X)



A wetland plant with large white spathes and glossy green leaves. The faint scent attracts pollinating insects to the flowers inside.



Melianthus major
kruidjie-roer-my-nie (A)
Ubuhlungubemamba (X)
Honey flower (E)



A shrub with dramatic and toothed leaves. Flowers are strongly scented and drip with nectar, making them irresistible to certain pollinators



Erica subdivaricata
Cup Heath (E)
Kubusheide (A)
Umsitshane (X)



A small, wiry shrub with tiny, needle-like leaves typical of Ericas. It is a reliable source of nectar, particularly for insects and sunbirds.
