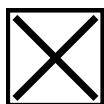

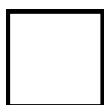
How many of these plants can you find in the garden?

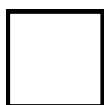
Helichrysum petiolare
Silver bush everlasting (E),
Kooigoed (A)



This woolly-leaved shrub is used extensively in traditional healing, ancestral rituals, and also burned as incense. Its silver foliage brings calm and contrast to indigenous gardens.



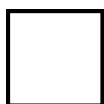
Melianthus major
Giant Honey flower (E),
Kruidjie-roer-my-nie (A)



A dramatic and interesting shrub with toothed leaves and dark maroon flowers, dripping with nectar and strongly scented.



Protea repens
Common Sugarbush (E),
Suikerbos (A)



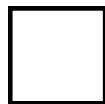
This fire-adapted shrub produces abundant nectar that is loved by sunbirds and pollinators across fynbos habitats.

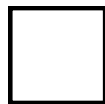
Lessertia frutescens

A well-known medicinal shrub with scarlet flowers and bitter-tasting leaves.



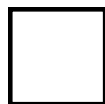
Eriocephalus africanus
Wildrosemary (E),
Kapokbos(A)



A strongly aromatic grey shrub with fluffy white seed heads. Birds use their fluffy, cottony seeds to line their nests.



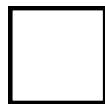
Carpobrotus edulis
Sourfig (E), Suurvy (A)



Sour figs sprawl on the ground, and the yellowish-red 'fig' has a unique sweet-and-sour taste!



Salvia aurea
Brown sage (E),
Geelblomsalie (A)



This resilient shrub with aromatic golden-green leaves and bronze, violet flowers attracts many pollinators.



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Zantedeschia aethiopica
Common arum lily (E)

Wit varkoor (A)

Intebe (X)

A wetland plant with large white spathes and glossy green leaves. The faint scent attracts pollinating insects to the flowers inside.



Leonotis leonurus

Lion's Ear (E),

Duiwelstabak (A)

A shrubby plant with whorls of orange flowers is used as a traditional remedy and attracts nectar-feeding birds, especially sunbirds.



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Watsonia tabularis

**Table Mountain watsonia(E),
Suurkanol (A)**



An elegant bulbous plant with tall spikes of pink to orange flowers in summer. Attracts sunbirds and is ideal for adding seasonal colour to gardens.



Pelargonium capitatum

**Rose-scented pelargonium (E),
Kusmalva (A)**



This soft-leaved shrub has sweetly rose-scented leaves and pink flowers. Valued in perfumery and traditional medicine for treating wounds and respiratory infections.
