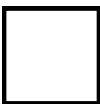
How many of these plants can you find in the garden?

Pelargonium capitatum
Rose-scented pelargonium (E),
Ikhubalo(X), Kusmalva (A)



This soft-leaved shrub has sweetly rose-scented leaves and pink flowers. Valued in perfumery and traditional medicine for treating wounds and respiratory infections.



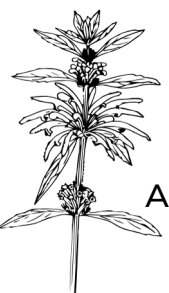
Elegia nuda
Naked Deckreed (E),
Dekriet (A)



A tufted, wind-resistant perennial grass once used for grazing and soilbinding, playing a role in erosion control, and providing cover and forage for wildlife.



Leonotis leonurus
Lion's Ear (E),
Umfinafincane (X),
Duiwelstabak (A)



A shrubby plant with whorls of orange flowers is used as a traditional remedy and attracts nectar-feeding birds, especially sunbirds.

Salvia aurea
Brown sage (E), Usikiki (X)
Geelblomsalie (A)



This resilient shrub with aromatic golden-green leaves and bronze, violet flowers attracts many pollinators.



Osteospermum incanum
Greybietou (E)



A low-growing shrub with silvery-grey foliage and bright yellow daisy-like flowers. Drought-tolerant and ideal for colour contrast in gardens.



Melianthus major
Giant Honeyflower (E),
Ubuhlungubemamba (X),
Kruidjie-roer-my-nie (A)



A dramatic and interesting shrub with toothed leaves and dark maroon flowers, dripping with nectar and strongly scented.



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
